United Hospital District Accepts Bomgaars Donation

Funds will be applied to enhanced 3D mammography equipment upgrades

Blue Earth, MN – February 13, 2020 – United Hospital District (UHD) has accepted a donation of \$722.05 from Bomgaars Corporation. The donation represents 5% of evening sales from the Blue Earth store during the fifth annual Ladies Night event held October 27, 2019. In keeping with Bomgaars' request to utilize the funds for cancer awareness or screening efforts, UHD will apply the funds towards the purchase of enhanced 3D mammography screening equipment.

Bomgaars Ladies Night aims to raise awareness of women's health issues by offering a 20% discount to ladies in attendance during event hours. 2019 marks the second time UHD has been selected as a local beneficiary of the event. UHD's 2018 proceeds were used to sponsor a team at American Cancer Society's Relay For Life event, which raised over \$125,000.00 to support local cancer patients and their families.

Although poor weather interrupted this year's sales activity at some locations, Bomgaars' 2019 donation for all 88 participating locations was \$40,015.92, representing an increase of 12.48% from last year. The award to UHD increased almost 5%.

UHD is pleased to partner with Bomgaars and salutes their commitment to women's health.

UHD, located in Blue Earth, MN, is a system of care comprised of a 25-bed acute care hospital, comprehensive outpatient services, adolescent treatment center, ambulance service and home health/hospice care all supported by a 20-plus multi-specialty provider group with four clinic locations across two counties.
